- Elected Officials / Staff Updates
  - Supervisor Ellenberg Steve Kline
    - Sup Ellenberg at WG Farm Market 2/19
    - Mental Health declared public health care crisis; alternatives to new jail
    - fire on Menker Ave; 1 person died: a hoarder; n'brs had complained about conditions, but code enforcement only issued fines.
    - County redistricting not yet finalized; to be set by 2nd mtg in March.
  - Councilmember Davis Mary Anne Groen
    - "State of the District" 2/16
    - redistricting took effect 2/11
    - Concerns about Nitrous Oxide cartridges from vape shops: will try to ban

- Board and Commission Updates
  - Neighborhood Commission Jim Carter
    - MCAT at 2/9: Mobile Crisis Assessment Team for mental problems
    - Reimagining Public Safety advisory cmte (w/ 28 members)
    - Budget letter being drafted
    - 4 strike teams (1 sgt + 4 officers + 1 drone in each team) + a dedicated dispatcher for responding to fireworks.
    - All District Leadership Group: next mtg 3/12; Greg Peck past chair
  - Parks & Rec Commission Art Maurice (D6); Larry Ames (D3)
    - staff reported on sustainability report on all parks: maintenance
- Advocacy and Community Group updates
  - Save Our Trails -- Bill Rankin
    - Board mtg in March: know of anyone interested?
  - SJ Park Advocates -- Jean Dresden
    - continued discussion on Park Trust Fund, PDO/PIO, nexus, etc.
      >> D6NLG letter to Task Force and/or Council? (See Jean's '<u>talking points'</u>)<sup>3</sup>
    - Hour-long discussion on PDO/PIO park funding policy; now charged only on residential: should we advocate for also charging on new commercial? Different zones? Council boundaries limitations? Regional vs N'hood parks? Inequity: 800x more \$ in D3 vs D7. Compare "city customs" vs state law policy reqmnts. Talking points were reviewed. Agreed on listed set of priorities; include Commercial; retain residential fees; discuss allocations. Motion (by Ed, 2nd by Harvey) for Larry/Jean/Helen/Art work to write letter, and then mail ASAP w/o further D6NLG review. Approved by consensus, w/ Helen abstaining (as she's on the Fee Cmte).
    - [Drafting subcmte worked on drafting letter; submitted <u>letter</u><sup>4</sup> 2/14/22]
    - other park issues Running late; will save for next time
- Continued from last month:
  - continued discussion on <u>2nd draft<sup>5</sup></u> of D6NLG Guidelines (in lieu of bylaws),
    >> and possible adoption
    - discussed. Harvey makes motion, Art 2nds, to approve: just remove the word "bylaws". <u>Guidelines</u><sup>6</sup> approved by consensus.
  - D6NLG Finances, and status on the returning of the grant from UNSCC -- Bill Rankin
    - Check sent to UNSCC was returned by US Post Office; resent and now received.
    - waiting for receipts from James Rincon to reconcile accounts, so that D6NLG can got out of "Not in good stead" status. Need to account for ~\$500.
  - updates on the redrawing of Council and County District boundary lines -- Jean Dresden skip
- Actions or precautions for Covid omicron? skip; will continue meeting by Zoom.
